



Write 4 sentences about your favourite toy and other members of your family's favourite toys when they were little. Can you use 'because' to explain why it was their favourite?



Create a marble run.



Learn to spell the days of the week: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Your child will be tested on these on Monday 24th June and Monday 15th July.

Practise identifying coins and notes by selecting different amounts for them to put in bun cases.



To keep this simple, put the value of one coin/note e.g. 50p or £10. For a challenge, use a few coins to make the amount, e.g. £5.23 or 27p. You could even try buying something at the shop but make sure your parents go with you!

- What was school like when they were little?
- Is there anything else that has changed?

Can you spot anything that is similar or different to now?
