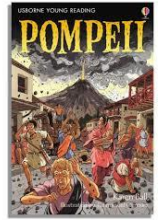




# How did the Romans change Britain?

## As Artists / Musicians / Designers we can...

- ✓ Study the use of mosaics in Roman times and create our own mosaic as a class
- ✓ Sculpt clay to make Roman coins
- ✓ Improvise and sing in a gospel style
- ✓ Play a bass part and rhythms ostinato

## As Religious Observers / Model Citizens we can ...

- ✓ Learn about positive friendships (including online) and know how to respect similarities and differences
- ✓ Discuss why some people think that life is a journey. Learn about how and why different religions celebrate special and sacred times

## As Sports People we can...

- ✓ Learn to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- ✓ Use dance to communicate ideas about the Romans

## As Readers and Writers we can...

- ✓ Write *diaries* from the point of view of a Roman soldier
- ✓ Read texts and write a narrative with a *historical* setting of a Celtic village
- ✓ Improve vocabulary using Vocabulary Ninja

## As Geographers / Historians we can...

- ✓ Locate English cities where the Romans settled and learn why most cities are located by a river
- ✓ Know how Britain changed from the Iron Age to the end of the Roman occupation
- ✓ Learn how the Romans helped to advance British society
- ✓ Learn about resistance to the Roman occupation in Britain and know about Boudica
- ✓ Know about at least one famous Roman emperor

- ✓ Explore the world wide web to discover who owns content and find out what they can add, access and create.
- ✓ Evaluate online content to check if it is reliable

## As Mathematicians we can...

- ✓ Understand the values of each digit in numbers up to 10,000
- ✓ Partition, compare and order numbers to 10,000
- ✓ Round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000
- ✓ Explore how to read and write Roman Numerals
- ✓ Add 1's, 10's, 100's and 1000's
- ✓ Add and subtract 4 digit numbers using the column method and exchanging numbers

- ✓ Identify the Polish words for greetings and numbers 1-10
- ✓ Know where Poland is in the world
